Rudolph's Tree Decorations



SANTA'S FAVOURITE SHORTBREAD



You'll need:

250g unsalted butter
softened at room temperature
125g caster sugar
240g plain flour

Makes 20 biscuits

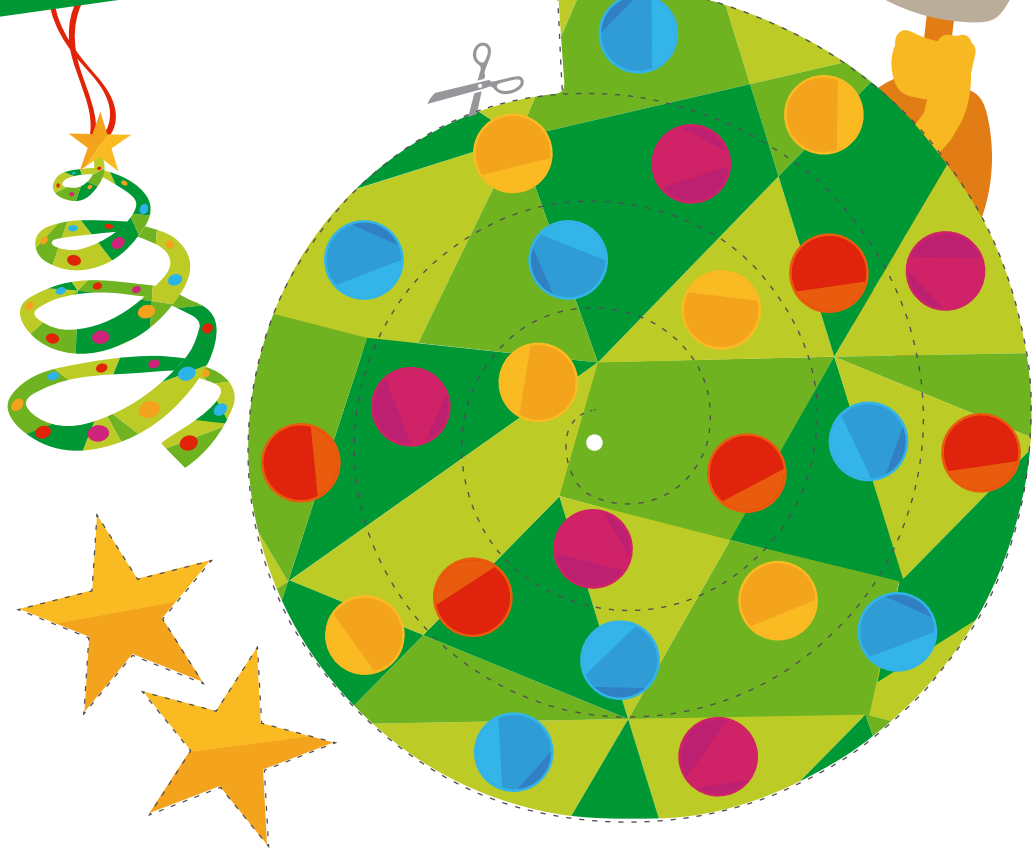
- Heat oven to 150°C and line two oven trays with baking paper
- Beat butter in a bowl with a wooden spoon until soft and smooth
- Add sugar and plain flour, and work the mixture with the spoon until blended
- Knead the dough lightly on a floured surface to form a firm dough. Chill for 20 minutes
- Divide dough into two portions and roll out each between 2 sheets of baking paper to a thickness of 5-7mm
- Cut the dough into Christmassy shapes. Place onto oven trays and bake for 15-20 minutes, or until pale and dry
- When cooled, decorate with coloured icing, melted chocolate or edible silver balls.

FESTIVE GIFT TAGS

Cut around the circles below, make a small hole and thread some ribbon through.

- Make a small hole in the top of the spiral and thread some ribbon through the hole
